

CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION AWARD



Appaloosa Youth Association Recognition Program

The Certificate of Recognition is awarded to deserving youth for outstanding accomplishments using an Appaloosa horse. The accomplishments should be of major importance, indicating proficiency in such areas as promotion of the Appaloosa breed, education, social activities, leadership, organization participation, and community service.

Youth who receive the Certificate of Recognition will be selected from applicants nominated by an individual other than themselves or their parents. These applications will be reviewed by the ApHC Youth Committee and must meet specific qualification requirements listed on this page.

The youths who receive the Certificate of Recognition will receive a personalized award and their photo will appear in *Appaloosa Journal*. Applications must be completed and received in the ApHC office by June 10.

To be eligible for this award, youth applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Must be a member of the Appaloosa Youth Association.
- Nominations must be made by 4-H leaders, FFA instructors, other youth leaders, Regional Club Officers or person that is not parent of applicant.
- The youth nominated does not have to own an Appaloosa but must have used on in the endeavors her or she is being given recognition for.
- May not have received the Certificate of Recognition previously.
- A complete resume of the applicant's accomplishments and activities must be received in the ApHC office by June 10.

A photograph of the applicant must be attached to the application for recognition purposes. Inkjet printed photos or color copies of photos will not be accepted.
